Corey A. Frazier is a former NASA engineer, technologist, and debut novelist. His speculative sci-fi novel *ORION: Heavenfall*—winner of the Chanticleer Cygnus Sci-Fi Award First Place—was born from thirty years of world-building that began as a comic book sketched in a childhood bedroom. He lives in Portland, Oregon.

Corey spent seven years at NASA, working on the Space Shuttle program including the final servicing mission to the Hubble Space Telescope. He then spent over fifteen years in the technology sector at the intersection of innovation and supercomputing. *ORION: Heavenfall* is the first book in the *ORION* series, a cinematic speculative sci-fi saga designed from the ground up as a transmedia property.
